Irwin Hoffman defeated Max Warren Foltz; and Ken Howe and John Atkinson.

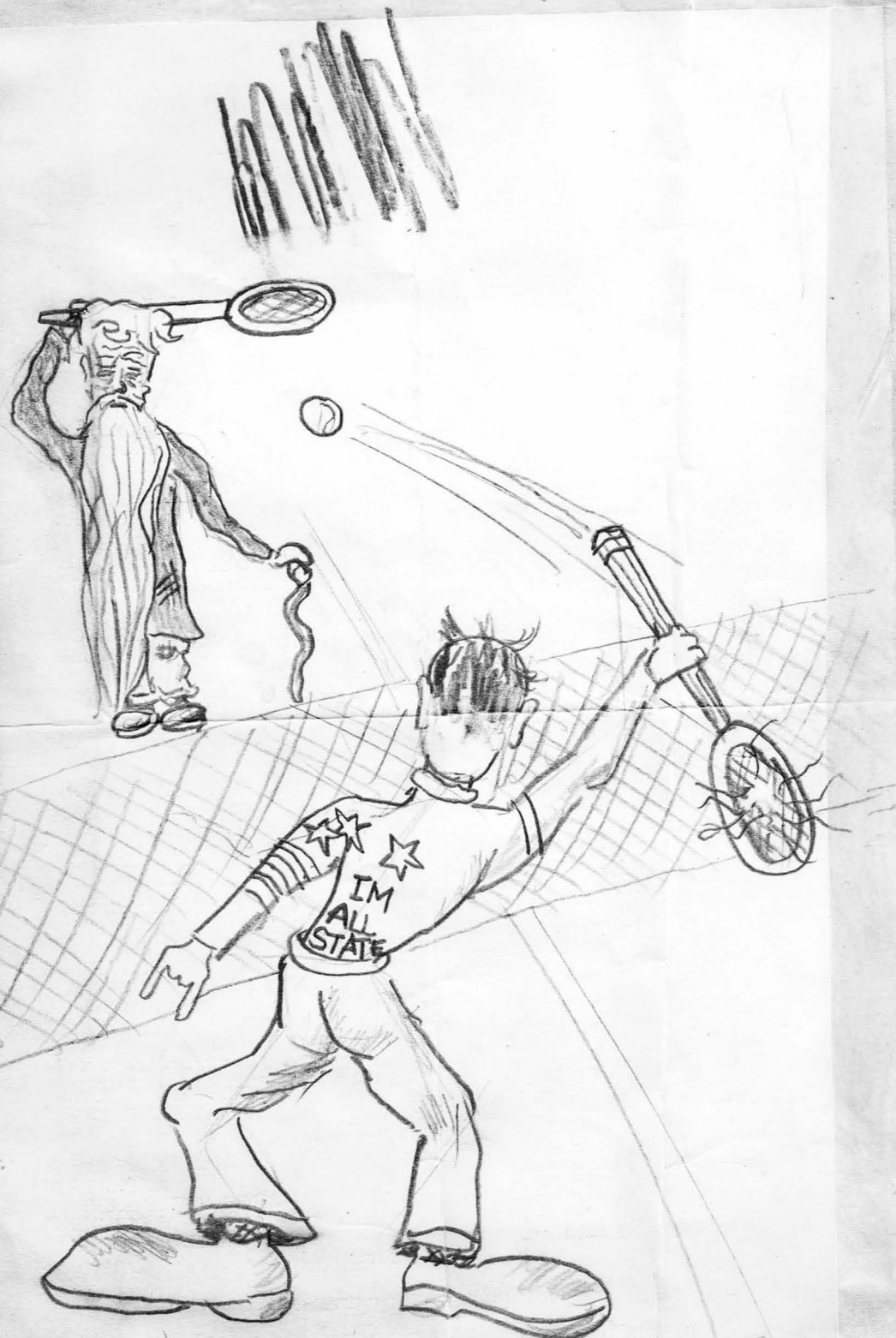
Bob Stewart and Frank Braum still have a first round match to play with the winner meeting Bob Anderson in the second bracket.
