

D. U. TENNIS TEAM BEATS TEXAS TECH

LUBBOCK, Tex., March 25.—Denver university's tennis team was to meet Texas Christian university in Fort Worth Tuesday afternoon after breezing through Texas Tech, 5-1, here Monday.

Richard Clarke and Jim Burgess saved the Red Raiders from a shut-out by winning the No. 2 doubles, 7-5, 6-4 in the day's final match.

Clayton Benham won No. 1 singles over David Clark, 6-0, 6-2; Jack Ter Borg took No. 2 singles from Buddy Satterwhite, 6-1, 6-1; Irwin Hoffman rallied in No. 3 singles 5-7, 6-3, 6-2 over Richard Clarke, and Alvin Willis concluded the singles sweep with a 6-4, 6-3 decision from Jim Burgess.

Benham and Ter Borg teamed to down Tech's No. 1 doubles team of Clark and Satterwhite 6-4, 6-3. Hoffman and Willis plated No. 2 doubles.
