## HEALTH INSURANCE ENROLLMENT DATES AND INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS

Under the terms of the contract with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, the Kaiser Health Plan of Colorado, and COMPRECARE, employees may transfer health insurance coverage from one company to another company during the month of January with the change becoming effective March 1, 1978.

Employees who are now enrolled in Kaiser or COMPRECARE also may add eligible dependents during the month of January with the coverage becoming effective March 1, 1978. (Note: This does not apply to a newly acquired dependent who can be added within thirty-one days of the date the employee acquires the new dependent.)
