

GW Cited for Computer Work

George Washington High School, 655 S. Monaco Pkwy., has been cited for "Exemplary Cases in Academic Computing" in five of six categories established by the Human Resources Research Organization, through a research project sponsored by the National Science Foundation.

There were 106 educational institutions in the United States selected from approximately 7,000 responding to surveys on the use of computers for teaching and learning.

George Washington High School was cited in the categories of student accomplishments, spectrum of applications, computer literacy, computer science or data processing curriculum, and outreach.
